Our March speaker is John Burns. He enlisted in the Army Infantry in 1987. He served in combat with the 75th Ranger Regiment in Panama (1989-90), Operation Desert Storm (1990-91), and in Mogadishu, Somalia (1993). On October 3, 1993, John Burns was a staff sergeant and a squad leader when his Ranger unit came under heavy Somali fire.

The book and film *Black Hawk Down* were based on those events. John was wounded multiple times, and he was awarded the Bronze Star Medal with Valor device for his actions and leadership that day.
